

Terminated Lease 6374 History - Supplemental Auction Information

Date	Event/Action
3/12/2012	State Historical Society of North Dakota indicates there are no known significant sites in Section 16, Township 159 North, Range 100 West.
10/25/2012	North Dakota Department of Trust Lands (DTL) met with Crushed Rock Sales LLC (CRS) to review a mining plan.
11/20/2012	CRS enters into a lease agreement for gravel with DTL. Royalty rate is set at 4.95 per CY.
9/18/2017	DTL and CRS extend the lease agreement for a 2-year term.
9/24/2019	DTL notifies CRS that their lease extension request has been approved for a 2-year term.
2/1/2020	CRS lease has been terminated, and CRS forfeited their property to the Board of University and School Lands.
4/27/2023	DTL receives bids to measure and grade four aggregate stockpiles.
6/8/2023	DTL contracts Brosz Engineering, Inc to measure four construction aggregate stockpiles with an unmanned aerial vehicle. Brosz Engineering Inc provided DTL with measurements in cubic yards and provided a report including spatial data (See map document).
6/26/2023	DTL receives stockpile measurements from Brosz Engineering Inc.
6/26/2023	DTL contracted Braun Intertec Corporation to sample four construction aggregate stockpiles for materials testing. Braun Intertec Corporation was required to conduct a mechanical analysis (sieve analysis with 20 washes, per sample) on the samples and provide a report to DTL.
8/4/2023	Braun Intertec Corporation provided mechanical analysis to DTL (See map document).
