## FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, REPEAL, AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE the Department of Trust Lands, on behalf of the Board of University and School Lands, will hold a public hearing to address adoption, repeal, and amendment to rules contained in N.D. Admin. Code Title 85, at 10:00 a.m. CT, on October 26, 2021, at the Fort Totten Room, North Dakota State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed rules is to implement statutory changes to the North Dakota Century Code through adoption, amendment, or repeal of administrative rules. The proposed rules address amendments to General Administration – Definitions; amendments, repeals, and adoption of rules concerning Unclaimed Property; the repeal of Surface Land Management - Public Access and Use; and amendments to Minerals Management Reports of Lessee – Delinquency Penalty.

The proposed rules are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rulemaking implements statutory changes made in HB 1080 regarding royalty payments, HB 1081 regarding public access and use, and SB 2048 regarding unclaimed property enacted during the most recent legislative session.
