Topsoil is removed to full depth and stockpiled separately of subsoil, aggregate, rock etc. Subsoil and aggregates are prospected to full depth of deposit. GPS coordinates are recorded for each test hole. Each test hole is sampled and photographed. Test hole layers are measured and recorded to the entire depth. The test hole coordinate locations are placed on a map of the prospected area. Each hole is backfilled with the material going back into the hoe as it came out, bottom first. Test holes are compacted prior to topsoil replacement. Topsoil is replaced over exposed test hole. Disturbed area is seeded with native grass which is raked into disturbed area.
